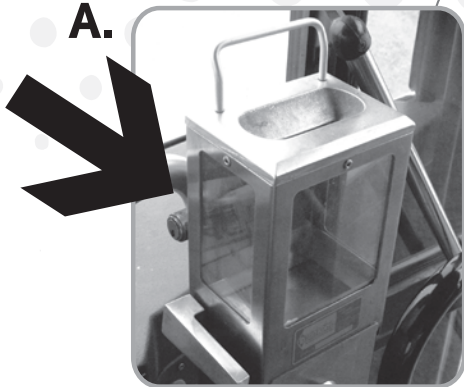




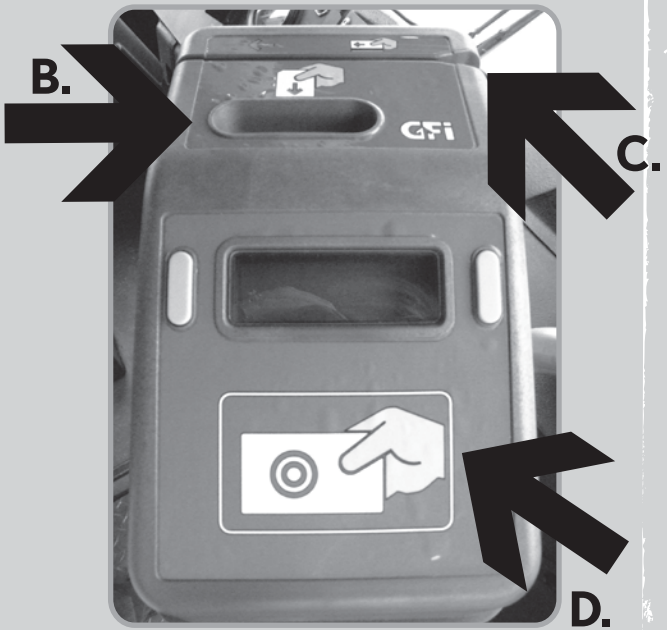

A. Cash Box: Put exact change in opening at the top of the Cash Fare Box. Tell the driver if you are purchasing a single trip or a one day pass. If you are purchasing a one day pass, take your pass from the Card Slot (B). All other passes must be purchased at a pass outlet.



B. Card Slot: Insert your pass with the magnet stripe facing the driver and the ValleyRide logo at the top of the card. Let go of your pass. Take your pass when it pops back up. See the back of your pass for time or value stamp.

C. Card Reader: Slide your pass through the slot from right to left, with the magnetic strip facing toward you.

D. Circle Pad: Briefly hold your pass above the pad with the red circles. The stripes on the pass should be facing up.
